
extracts.




As Mathematicians we will be continuing to look at our understanding of fractions as well as exploring measure of mass and capacity and time.



As Writers we will be undertaking some short burst writing with focus on use of prepositions, adjectives and subordinate clauses. We will be exploring the features of a good description and applying our knowledge of story openings. Through our reading we will explore how to write a change story.







As Geographers we will be studying the form and function of Rivers. We will explore the terminology and structure of rivers and their role in our landscape, including understanding the water cycle.



THEOLOG\

As athletes We will continue to explore Bushcraft techniques including use of tool, forest crafts and fire craft. In tennis will be learning about to use the ready position to return a ball, to hit the ball to different parts of the court using a forehand hit, to perform an underarm serve to start a rally, to move towards a ball to return it over the net, to play cooperatively with a partner to keep the ball moving over the net, to perform forehand hits to score points in a competition.

> As Linguists we will be learning French through Rigolo, including describing people, days of the week and animals and pets.

As Theologians We will be studying Christianity: Jesus' Miracles – Could Jesus heal people? As Musicians we will be learning 'Bringing us together', this is a Disco song about friendship, peace, hope and unity. We will learn to sing and play parts of the song on musical instruments like recorders and glockenspiels, as well as comparing the style to other similar songs.
