School Lunches ~ Current Preschool and Year 2 children

If your Preschool (Caterpillars) child will be moving to Reception (Butterflies) in September, they could qualify for Free School Meals.

For the current Year 2 children who are moving to Dragonflies in September remember that you will need to pay £2.53 a day/ £12.65 a week for their school lunches, however you may also qualify for Free School meals.

To apply please log on to www.norfolk.gov.uk/neo and follow the instructions for applying for Free School Meals. If you have any issues with your application, please contact the school office for assistance. All applications are confidential.

If your child is not in Preschool or Year 2 but your circumstances have changed, please apply online as described above as you may well now qualify.
