As Readers we will be learning Shakespeare's comedy A Midsummer Night's Dream. We will explore how a misplaced good deed caused chaos for those around Puck.



As Mathematicians we will be spending time understanding how to correctly use ratio, algebra and percentages to build on our work with decimals. We will look to hone our addition and subtraction skills, ensuring our strategies are secure and efficient.



As Writers we will be undertaking some short burst writing to consolidate our learning on building suspense and exploring a character ignoring their warning. We will explore Shakespeare's style in a Midsummer Night's Dream and apply this to our own dream-like tale.



As Scientists we will further explore materials by investigating reversible and irreversible changes.



As Historian we will explore WWII including the events leading up to Neville Chamberlain's declaration of war to how the war ended.



As athletes we will be understanding how to increase speed over distance during athletics, developing new skills which support co-ordination. We will have opportunities to build our own circuit in PE as part of Health and Well-Being week in addition to experiencing fencing.



As Linguists we will be continuing our learning how to express where we are going in the world and the different weathers we may face.



In **PSHE** we will be further exploring the zones of regulation and what tools we can access independently to support managing our emotions.



In **Computing** we will be exploring 3-D software and how to manipulate and improve shapes, whilst considering how these may translate into a real-life object.
