As Readers we will be learning the story of Red. This will support the children's understanding of building suspense for a reader, making sure they are kept on their toes.



As Mathematicians we will be spending time ensuring we have a secure knowledge and understanding of place value. We will be sure to revise what this term means and how it is applied within a mathematical environment.



As Writers we will be undertaking some short burst writing with the use of a variety of images, which will also include a grammatical focus. We will be exploring how to make our writing engaging and fluid by the correct and efficient use of punctuation and more adventurous vocabulary,=.
